#### THE AWARDS

The Australian Acoustical Society, Queensland Division conducts an educational awards program to encourage and support education and research in acoustics in Queensland. Applications are sought for the 2013 Colin G Speakman Travel Bursaries.

Two (2) bursaries of up to **\$1200** are provided to assist with travel and registration costs associated with attendance at ACOUSTICS 2013 *Science, Technology and Amenity*, the national conference of the Australian Acoustical Society, to be held at Victor Harbor, South Australia 17-19 November 2013.

To be eligible for travel assistance through these awards, applicants must be a student at a university in Queensland, engaged in research in an area relevant to acoustics, towards the award of an Honours, Masters or higher degree and must be presenting a paper at the conference.

#### THE SOCIETY

The Australian Acoustical Society is a learned society formed in 1971 to advance the science and practice of acoustics. ## HOW TO APPLY

1. Applicants for a travel bursary must complete the following application form.
2. Applications shall be made through the responsible academic supervisor who will review the application for its worthiness prior to forwarding to the Awards Committee.
3. Submissions close **5.00 pm, Friday, 30<sup>th</sup> August 2013**. Late applications will not be considered.
4. The Awards Committee will review the submissions and select the two most outstanding.

Note: Where there are several suitable submissions, the Committee, at its discretion, may elect to award more than two bursaries. In such cases, the total funds allocated will be apportioned between the several awardees. Monies shall be apportioned, in such a manner as the Committee in its competence shall elect.

In all cases, the decision of the Awards Committee shall be final.
