Speaker: Dr Gilles Pigasse, Danish Road Institute, Denmark

Dr Gilles Pigasse currently works with the Road Directorate of Denmark where he is an acoustic engineer primarily involved in optimising the performance of road traffic noise reducing devices including low noise asphaltic pavements and noise barriers.

Prior to this, Gilles worked for the Centre for Applied Hearing Research at the Technical University of Denmark which is where he gained his PhD, and also served an internship at the Sony Advanced Technical Centre in Germany.

Gilles has an MSc in Electrical Engineering from Aalborg University in Denmark and the School of Electrical Engineers in Paris, and has a BSc from Université Marne-La-Vallée in Paris.

Gilles talk will be on road traffic noise abatement measures used in Denmark and Europe as well as the use of planning tools, criteria and current EU research projects. However, Gilles is also happy to chat afterwards on his work at the Centre for Applied Hearing Research.
