THE AWARDS

The Australian Acoustical Society, Queensland Division conducts an educational awards program to encourage and support education and research in acoustics in Queensland. Applications are sought for the 2014 Colin G Speakman Travel Bursaries.

Three (3) bursaries of up to **\$1200** are provided to assist with travel and registration costs associated with attendance at INTERNOISE 2014 *Improving the World through Noise Control*, the 43rd International National Congress on Noise Control Engineering, to be held in Melbourne, Victoria 16 -19 November 2014.

Applicants must be a student at a university in Queensland, engaged in research in an area relevant to acoustics, towards the award of an Honours, Masters or higher degree and must be presenting a paper at the conference.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Applicants for a travel bursary must complete the following application form.
2. Applications shall be made through the responsible academic supervisor who will review the application for its worthiness prior to forwarding to the Awards Committee.
3. Submissions close **5.00 pm, Friday, 29th August 2014**. Late applications will not be considered.
4. The Awards Committee will review the submissions and select the three most outstanding.

Note: Where there are several suitable submissions, the Committee, at its discretion, may elect to award more than three bursaries. In such cases, the total funds allocated will be apportioned between the several awardees. Monies shall be apportioned, in such a manner as the Committee in its competence shall elect.

In all cases, the decision of the Awards Committee shall be final.
