THE AWARDS

The Australian Acoustical Society, Queensland Division conducts an educational awards program to support education and research in acoustics in Queensland. Applications are sought for the 2015 Colin G Speakman Travel Bursaries.

Two (2) bursaries of up to **\$1200** are provided to assist with travel and registration costs associated with attendance at *ACOUSTICS 2015*, to be held at Cypress Lakes Resort, Polkolbin, Hunter Valley, NSW 15 -18 November 2015.

Applications for a bursary to assist with travel and registration costs associated with presentation at other conferences, relevant to the science and practice of acoustics, are welcomed and will be considered, on their merit, on a case by case basis.

Applicants must be a student at a university in Queensland, engaged in research in an area relevant to acoustics, towards the award of an Honours, Masters or higher degree and must be presenting a paper at the conference.

THE SOCIETY

The Australian Acoustical Society is a learned society formed in 1971 to advance the science and practice of acoustics. Members practise or study in a wide range of areas including architectural acoustics, engineering noise and vibration control, underwater acoustics, bioacoustics, ultrasonics, environmental and occupational noise and vibration, acoustic and vibration transducers, speech communication, hearing and speech physiology, audiology and music acoustics.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Applicants for a travel bursary must complete the following application form.
- 2. Where the bursary sought is in relation to a conference other than ACOUSTICS 2015, the application must be accompanied by additional documentation giving particulars of the conference and its relevance to the applicant's area of acoustical research.
- 3. Applications shall be made through the responsible academic supervisor who will review the application for its worthiness prior to forwarding to the Awards Committee.
- 4. Submissions for travel bursaries in relation to ACOUSTICS 2015, close **5.00 pm**, **Friday**, **28th August 2015**. Late applications will not be considered.
- 5. Where a travel bursary is sought for participation at another conference, applications will be considered on a case by case basis, but should normally be submitted not later than eight weeks prior to conference commencement.
- 6. The Awards Committee will review the submissions and select the most outstanding.

Note: Where there are several suitable submissions, the Committee, at its discretion, may elect to award more than two bursaries. In such cases, the total funds allocated will be apportioned between the several awardees. Monies shall be apportioned, in such a manner as the Committee in its competence shall elect.

In all cases, the decision of the Awards Committee shall be final.
