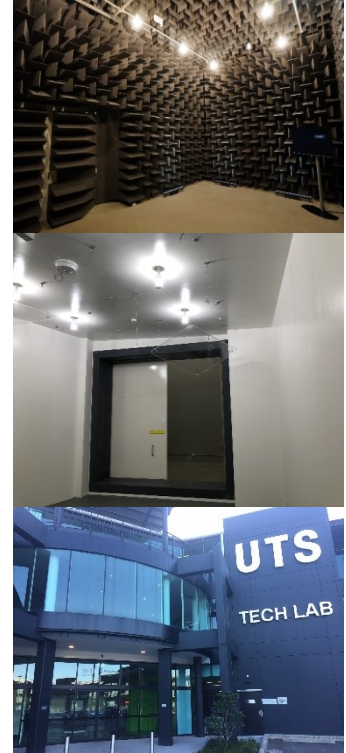

UTS recently opened a new engineering and technology facility in Botany. Tech Lab is the result of an investment of over \$60m by UTS and the facility hosts many different engineering laboratories covering 9000 m². Tech Lab also hosts brand new acoustics laboratories, including:

- Full anechoic chamber.
- Semi-anechoic chamber.
- Two reverberation rooms, with transmission loss suite.
- Hearing room.

Tech Lab is designed to support collaboration between industry and universities, and these new acoustic facilities will be made available for testing and development work by companies.

Presentations and tour

This event will include a tour of the acoustics facilities and a demonstration of some of the projects currently being undertaken by the Centre for Audio, Acoustics and Vibration (CAAV) at UTS. There will also be a short presentation describing the many ways in which companies can work with UTS, and how these laboratories will be used to support the local and national acoustics communities. This will include plans for NATA accreditation, undertaking standards testing, and opportunities for product development.
