Senior Lecturer in Audiology, School of Health and Rehabilitation Sciences

University of Queensland

Talk title: "Insights into auditory processing disorders and early diagnostic

techniques for children"

Dr Wilson's extensive interests in audiology include current research bettering our understanding of auditory processing and the development of the central auditory system; use of simulations in training and education of audiology students; development and extension of a number of rapid diagnostic audiometric technologies; and improved signal processing of auditory evoked potentials to better spot auditory dysfunction.
