An Overview of the Noise and Vibration Measurement and Evaluation Techniques used in the Automotive Industry

Automotive Noise, Vibration and Harshness (NVH) in a vehicle development environment involves almost everyone from vehicle designer to customer. It also represents a high risk to vehicle manufacturers in terms of warranty costs and brand image should a vehicle's NVH level not meet the market's expectations.

The NVH practitioner utilises a global understanding of the vehicle system and links it with an understanding of the market place to be a customer advocate. An assessment and judgement of a vehicle component or entire vehicle system often involves both qualitative and quantitative methods with targets and criteria developed over decades of corporate experience.

An introduction to the basic NVH assessment methods is offered in this presentation (including sound quality metrics, order analyses and on-road test techniques). NVH improvements will be illustrated using sound-bytes and data plots.


