Following the AGM, Professor Emeritus Lex Brown will give a presentation on Noise Events in Road Traffic Streams.

Abstract

A key question for road traffic noise management is whether prediction of human response to road traffic noise could be improved by accounting for noise events in road traffic streams in addition to energy equivalent, or percentile, measures of noise exposure. However, there is a critical prior question: how should noise events in road traffic be measured? This talk will report on an ongoing study of possible event-based indicators.

About the Presenter

Lex Brown is Professor of Environmental Planning at Griffith University. His initial training was in civil engineering and urban and regional planning, with a doctorate in environmental acoustics.

He has worked with WHO Europe in the revision of the Guidelines for Community Noise, and is a Board Member of the International Commission on the Biological Effects of Noise. He was also coeditor of the WHO publication on the Burden of Disease from Environmental Noise. In 2016 he was elevated to Fellow of the AAS.
