The name of the author who will present the paper should be asterisked. The abstract should include the aim of the study, an outline of the methodology, the main results and the conclusions. Abstracts should be descriptive and concise. Please use tabs or indents (not hard spaces) and do not use printing enhancements such as fonts, italics, underlining, bold etc. Do not include figures or tables in the abstract. Abstracts should be prepared as a Microsoft Word document and submitted as an attachment via email to [acoustics2005@acoustics.asn.au](mailto:acoustics2005@acoustics.asn.au).
